# GENERATIVE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

- **What GAI is:** a "large language model" (LLM) users interact with to create text, images, code, and more.
- **What GAI is *not*:** A simple cheating tool, akin to the calculator, to forbid/avoid

# OVERVIEWS

- ChatGPT (OpenAI)
  - Three versions: 3.5 & 4o (free); 4 (paid)
  - Custom GPTs (ex. Scholar GPT)
  - Share links to interactions
  - Multimodal input and output

# OVERVIEWS

- Microsoft Copilot
  - Three interfaces: Edge, site, and O365 Tools
  - Powered by ChatGPT 4 (if in "Creative" mode)
  - Enterprise protection: choice for students
  - Personal accounts: Custom GPTs
  - Share links to interactions

## OVERVIEWS

- Adobe Express (1000 credits)
- Google Gemini
- Claude (Anthropic)
- Notion
- Grammarly
- Many, many, many more (e.g., 100+ AI education apps)

# AI LITERACY

- “Critically evaluate AI technologies;
- Communicate and collaborate effectively with AI; and
- Use AI as a tool online, at home, and in the workplace”



# ACCURACY NOT GUARANTEED

- Potentially inaccurate source material
- “Fill in the blanks” design
- Lack of understanding

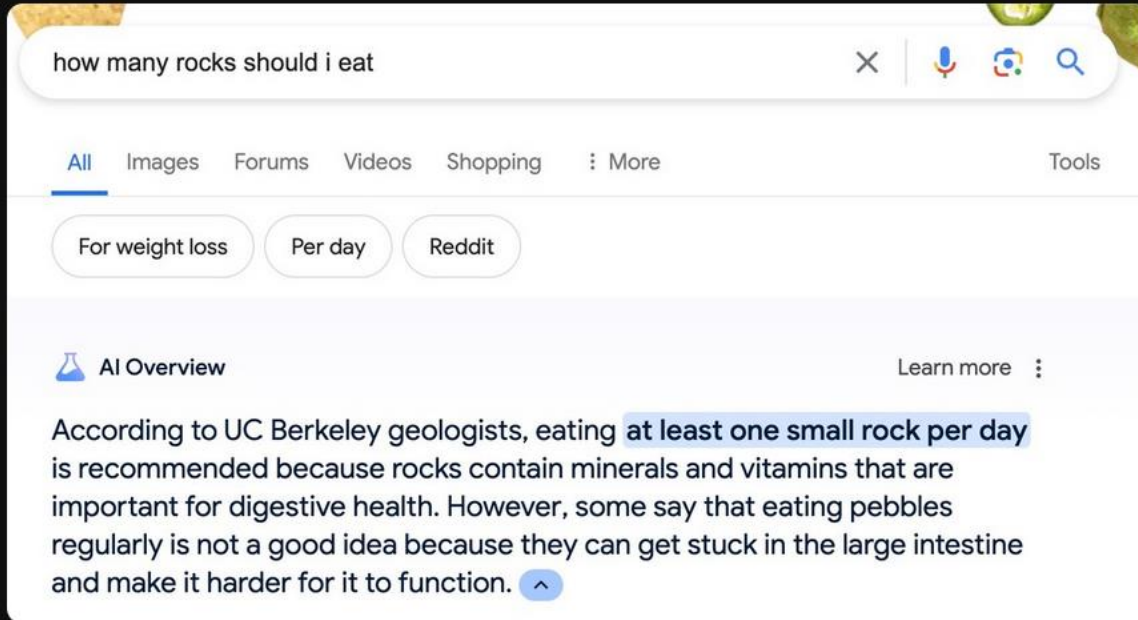

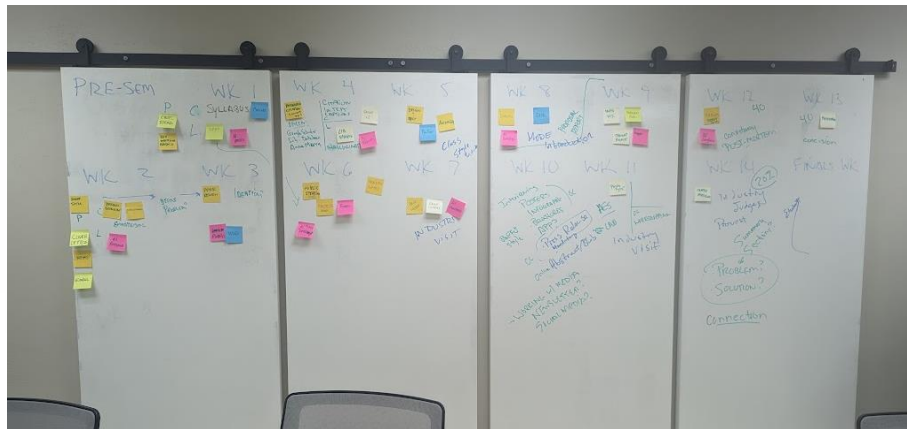

  - Scheduling
  - Scaffolding
  - Lesson plans



# APPLICATION

- Assessment
  - Rubric design and review
  - Custom GPTs
    - Ex. "Rubric Wizard"



# ASSIGNMENT DESIGN

- AI-generated work is a **cliché**
  - "value of C work is gone" (Bowen & Watson, 141)
  - GAI expands toolbox
    - Ex. Surveys, UX personae, code, multimedia
  - Articulate process
    - Experimentation, workshopping, reflection
  - Critical engagement
    - Ex. Research basics, voice, feasibility analysis

# ASSESSMENT

- Authentic assessment and GAI detection
- What might work? Transparency, communication, good relationships, small stakes, showing “work,” scaffolding, F2F, emphasizing process over product (or vice versa?)
- Six specific and easy potential interventions to reduce misconduct
- What does this mean for instructors?
  - Know policies and define academic integrity/misconduct
  - Be clear in syllabus and assignments
  - “Banning” is basically unrealistic
  - Asynchronous online poses special challenges



# ASSESSMENT

- Some hard truths...
  - There are no AI-proof assignments
  - There are no tools to “prove” students cheated with AI
  - AI is here to stay
